

- ➤ Quizzes on CBSE content for mathematics and science subjects at school level (6-10 class) are available on quizizz for Indian students.




## HOW TO ENTER IN QUIZIZZ?




**STEP 1**..... Go to <a href="https://quizizz.com">https://quizizz.com</a> and Click on "Sign up for free"



STEP2.... Or Log in .... Continue with Google or with Microsoft or sign up with email



**STEP 3**...... Lots of already created quiz are available in quizizz, if we want to use existing quiz created by other teachers/students, we can use the "Search for quizzes" box and browse.




## **CREATE OWN QUIZ FREELY IN QUIZIZZ:**

Apart from already existed quizzes on various subject at school level, teachers from school level, higher education and professional development can create their own quizzes in mathematics in easy way by using this web resource. Seven different types of questions multiple choice, open ended, fill in the blank, poll and draw can be created in quizizz including images can be created in free version, Match type, labelling, graphing, math response, hotspot, drag and drop, drop down, re-order, audio and video response can also be attached with questions but in paid features only. Let us try to learn how can we create quiz in free version step wise......

**STEP 1**...... For creating our own quiz, we have to select the "Create a quiz" or "create" panel, you will be asked to create a quiz or lesson,...for creating quiz ..select quiz then you have to fill the given form.

- Name this quiz.....
- > Choose relevant subject....
- ➤ Then Click on "next"



**STEP2**.....We will get option for creating a new question by selecting type of question...multiple choice, poll, fill in the blank, open ended or draw/ we can teleport questions from quizizz library too in our quiz by adding relevant questions


**STEP3**.....If we want to create multiple choice question, select that --- insert question (can add image too), as well as provide answers, and be sure to click the "correct" icon in front of correct answer.

If we want to create question using poll option, select that... insert question (can add image too), as well as provide options.

If we want to create open-ended question, select that.... insert question (can add image too)

If we want to create "fill in the blank" type question, select that....insert question (can add image too), as well as provide answers

- STEP 4..... we can assign time with each question from 5 seconds to 15 min as per nature of question
- STEP 5.... If have edited the quiz, click on edit ...make required changes and click on "Finish editing"
- **STEP 6** ...... After "finish editing", click on "save quiz"
- **STEP 7....** Only after saving quiz, we will get two options "start live quiz" and "assign homework"



### SHARE CREATED QUIZ WITH STUDENTS/AUDIENCE:

We can assign created quiz as "HOMEWORK" to students for practice at home by clicking on "ASSIGN HOMEWORK". When we will click on assign homework, custom deadline can be given to students for completing the homework, we can invite participants by sharing link or ask participants to open joinmyquiz.com and by giving game code. Reports can also be shared with students in paid version.

### **HOST LIVE QUIZ:**

After completing the quiz, we can host quiz lively with our participants by clicking on "Start a live quiz". After clicking on this we will get two modes of playing "classic mode" and "Instructor pace mode". In classic mode, students can progress at their own pace but their score board will be visible to teacher, in instructor mode, teacher can control displaying of each question so that all students can go through each question together.

STEP1... We can choose "START A LIVE QUIZ" if want to engage students lively in quiz.

**STEP2**..... After clicking on "Start a live quiz" .... we have to choose mode in which we want students should play... i.e. classic or instructor mode

**STEP3**..... Click on classic and choose further modes, team, classic or test (paid version) ...if want students should answer at their own pace, compete team wise, individually.

**STEP4**...... Whatever mode, we select, we will get a link and game code, that is shared with Students and they can go to www.quizizz.com/join and after inserting 6-digit code, they can participate in the live quiz or complete the homework.

**STEP 5** ..... Once the students will finish the quiz, we can refresh our page, can view the results of the quiz.
