II. Learning Words in the Modern Way:

This approach is called **indirect** and psychological because here the reader seeks the information, not as an end in itself, but as a means to an end. This also called **modern inductive method**, in that you first discover the word at work, then you are challenged by it, you guess its meaning, and you then confirm or correct your guess by referring to the dictionary. In this method, the words are no longer become the dead wood in the mind of the reader but living entities and charged with action and emotion.

III. Word Building by the Unfolding Process:

In this third method of development of vocabulary is slightly different direction but still we rely on indirect method. In this method that shows a word first in its context rather than flashing it on you alone and away from its meaning in a sentence. The meaning and uses of the following difficult words will be revealed by unfolding process. Even the reader is meeting a new word, he won't feel difficult because of the partial meaning will be revealed by its context and full meaning will gradually unfold before the chapter is over.

Read the following sentence, particularly the italicized words and attempting some judgment of its meaning.

- 1. He lives in severe and abstemious life.
- 2. Honesty is a *fetish* with him.
- 3. Only God is truly *omniscient*.
- 4. When John's treachery was discovered, he truly became a *pariah*.
- 5. The prisoner painted a *poignant* picture of his suffering.
