Rajasthan Foundation: Pravasi Rajasthanis' COVID-19 Relief Drive

In the of the challenging CIVD-19 pandemic, the RF assumed a leading role in the service of the people. During the lockdown, it functioned as a central hub, providing crucial assistance and support to Rajasthanis stranded in various states. Amid the challenges posed by the COVID-19 crisis, the RF took a proactive stance, actively engaging with prominent members of global Rajasthani community. Their heartfelt appeal encouraged collaboration in assisting those in need within their respective local communities, while simultaneously seeking their generous contributions to bolster the collective initiatives of their home state. This united effort played a vital role in mitigating the hardships faced by the state's residents during the global lockdown. This article highlights the Foundation's central role in acquiring and disbursing vital relief supplies and financial resources, demonstrating the strength of collaborative endeavors during times of crisis.

Allocation of oxygen concentrators and tankers: The RF, in collaboration with Pravasi Rajasthani, has assumed a central role in the acquisition and distribution of critical COVID-19 relief resources. A significant number of oxygen concentrators were dispatched to Rajasthan, with substantial portion allocated to district hospitals and healthcare centers (2941 in all). Additionally, valuable contributions came from various entities, including the American-India Foundation, Dubai-based NRRs and Shivanand Foundation. Notably, two oxygen tankers were generously donated by Dubai-based NRR, making a substantial impact on the oxygen supply in Jodhpur. RF expressed its gratitude through a Zoom event, acknowledging all contributors.

Deployment of oxygen plants and ventilators: The American-India Foundation played a vital role by installing oxygen plants at key healthcares facilities boosting local oxygen production at CHC Bayana, Bharatpur and SMS College, Jaipur. Additionally, Canada-based NRR Shri Navratan Kothari committed to

providing 3 oxygen plants and electric generators for healthcare centers in the Churu district. In the realm of ventilators, NRR Dr. Vivek Ojha donated eight emergency lung ventilators from the Czech Republic and American-India Foundation contributed 6000 single-use ventilators and 3000 monitors to SMS Medical College, Jaipur.

Other essential contributions and cash donations: RF received substantial support in various forms, including 200 oxygen cylinders from the Rajasthan Business & Professional Group, Dubai and a 400KW DG Set for Bhilwara Govt. Hospital donated by Dr. Akshat Jain from USA. Further, 100 Pulse Oxymeters were provided by the American-India Foundation to ESI hospital, Udaipur.

In a unique initiative, global NRRs have pledged to donate Peepal trees to create natural oxygen-emitted areas, supporting the Govt. of Rajasthan's plantation drive. Alongside material contributions, the RF also received significant cash donations (Rs. 15 Lacs) from global NRRs, with a total commitment of around Rs. 38 lacs for COVID-19 support. This is an exemplary illustration of unwavering commitment of Pravasi Rajasthanis to support the state govt. in its fight against the pandemic.

The commendable efforts of the RF, led and guided by Commissioner Shri Dhiraj Srivastava, during the Covid crisis, earned him the prestigious 'World Book of Records, London' recognition.

Rescue and Relief: RF's Role in Evacuating Rajasthani Citizens

The Ukraine-Russia war, which commenced in early 2022, cast a shadow of uncertainty over the lives of Rajasthani students and citizens who were caught in the crossfire. The Sudan and Manipur crisis of 2023 brought severe challenges for the Rajasthani diaspora, particularly students. Amidst the turmoil, the RF emerged as a lifeline, meticulously planning and executing the safe evacuation of these individuals, ensuring their well-being during these trying times. This research article delves into the pivotal role of the RF in coordinating and facilitating the secure repatriation of these individuals during a time of crisis in Ukraine, Sudan and Manipur.

Role as Nodal Officer: The Commissioner RF was appointed as the Nodal officer, a pivotal role that entailed close collaboration with the Ministry of External Affairs and Indian Embassies. This significant responsibility entailed working closely with these entities to facilitate the safe return of Rajasthani students from the conflict-ridden Ukraine, which had descended into a chaotic war zone. Similarly, the Commissioner RF played a vital role in the Sudan and Manipur crisis. Collaborating with the Ministry of External Affairs

and Indian Embassies, the Commissioner worked diligently to ensure the secure repatriation of Rajasthan's diaspora members facing turmoil in Sudan and Manipur.

Setting up assistance centers: The situation intensified when, on 24 February 2022, air routes were closed due to the escalating Ukraine-Russia conflict. In response to this critical development, the RF swiftly organized a help desk and control room, at the Indira Gandhi International Airport, Mumbai International Airport and Jaipur Airport. In March 2023, during the Sudan crisis, and in May 2023, amidst Manipur crisis, earthquake in Syria, RF played a crucial role in ensuring that Rajasthani individuals, who found themselves trapped in the midst of these conflicts, received vital assistance and guidance to enable their safe evacuation and repatriation to their home state.

Multi-pronged approach: RF's multi-faceted approach involved the creation of a three-tier system to manage the crisis effectively. Requests were received through various channels, including telephone and emails, in addition to names provided by public representatives and the Chief Minister's office. Furthermore, RF collected comprehensive information about students stranded in Ukraine and leveraged this data to create a WhatsApp group, facilitating continuous communication and moral support. Same course of action was followed up for Sudan and Manipur crisis.

Collaboration with government departments: Collaboration with various departments of the Rajasthan government allowed RF to conduct video conferences, instructing district collectors to remain in constant communication with the families of stranded students and citizens. This information flow was further bolstered by the establishment of a control room and helpline numbers.

Empowering the Diaspora: Notably, RF arranged video conferences with the assistance of expatriate Rajasthani individuals who had successfully reached Poland from Ukraine, providing them with a platform to share their experiences and concerns with the Hon'ble Chief Minister. This initiative fostered a sense of unity and support among the Rajasthani community during these trying times.

Achieving safe repatriation: Through collective efforts, RF and different govt. departments and the resilience of the stranded students and citizens, a significant milestone was achieved. By March11, 2022, a total of 1009 Rajasthani students and individuals had safely returned home from Ukraine. Rajasthani citizens were transported from Sudan to the port of Jeddah, Saudi Arabia and subsequently, they were flown and sailed to different cities in India, including Delhi, Mumbai, Ahmadabad, Bangalore and but of course different cities of Rajasthan. Out of approx. 100 returning individuals, 83 were successfully reunited with their families and homes, thanks to the assistance provided by the RF and the Rajasthan state govt. A total of 99 students from Manipur were brought back safely to Rajasthan at govt. expenses. The state govt. ensured their well-being, including accommodations, meals and transportation throughout the process. This

remarkable outcome showcases the RF's unwavering commitment to serving its people in times of crisis and exemplifies the power of coordinated humanitarian efforts.

RF's Visionary NRR Policy: A Historic Launch

The NRR Conclave marked a historic juncture with the Hon'ble Chief Minister's unveiling of the groundbreaking NRR Policy 7 Oct 2022. This momentous occasion saw the simultaneous launch of a new logo and a state-of-the-art website for the RF, symbolizing a heartfelt gift to the diaspora and emphasizing the state's profound dedication to its NRR community. The NRR policy, which has been formulated on the Five-C concept of connect, culture, community, care and contribution, aims to bring over one lakh NRRs under the Rajasthan Foundation, which was set up by the state government in 2001, in the next five years. This visionary document laid out a proactive role for the govt., aimed at fostering closer ties with the diapsora. It presented a comprehensive policy framework that delineated the state's commitment to NRRs, with a particular focus on their support, encouraging their investments in Rajasthan and ensuring their overall well-being.

The RF's proactive initiative commenced with a pivotal move, introducing a policy document that not only guided but also ushered in a transformative approach to fostering more extensive and meaningful connections with NRRs. These efforts foster a sense of belonging among NRRs. One of such much appreciated effort was organizing 'Chal Meri Dholaki Dhamak Dham', a puppet storytelling session narrated by Seema Mudra who joined from USA, successfully engaged young Pravasi kids in the past. It effectively made them aware of and connected them with their state's rich tradition and history. Through storytelling and puppetry, the workshop inspired a deep appreciation for their cultural heritage, fostering a sense of belonging and pride among the participants.

RF plays an important role in preserving and celebrating Rajasthan's rich cultural and heritage legacy. With a commitment to reconnecting the Rajasthani diaspora with their deep-root cultural and heritage, RF organized an engaging online talk show ' Science of ancient temples of Rajasthan' with Deepti Singh,

Professor in Cairo, Eygpt and Dr. Vikram Bhati, renowned historian and Assistant director at Research Institute, Chopasani, Jodhpur on 1ST May 2021. This event showcased the remarkable foresight of our ancestors and unveiled the advanced techniques and scientific knowledge applied in ancient temple construction in Rajasthan. Through such programs, RF acts as a cultural bridge, strengthening the diaspora's ties to their roots and fostering a profound connection with their spiritual, cultural and traditional heritage. This initiative not only celebrates Rajasthan's cultural treasures but also serves as a bridge between the past and the present, enlightening the diaspora about the scientific marvels of Rajasthan's ancient temples.

Welfare support and community building: In the 'Invest Rajasthan' summit held in Jaipur 2022, a significant proposal for 'Rajasthani Pravasi Bhawans' in various cities across the country and abroad was introduced. Reflecting a deep sense of pride and proactive engagement, RF stepped forward to support this initiative. Shayar Maloo, in a remarkable and generous gesture, donated her residence to establish the first Pravasi Bhawan in the state, located in Sujangarh, Churu. This initiative, supported by RF, vividly exemplified the organization's unwavering commitment to the well-being of the Rajasthani diaspora. In a recent addition (2023) to this initiative, a land in Coimbatore was allotted by Tamil govt. for Rajasthani Pravasi Bhawan on the request of CM, Govt. of Rajasthan and NRRs living in Tamilnadu further extending support for Rajasthani expatriates. These initiatives clearly showcase the significant contribution of the RF in forging connections, promoting well-being and nurturing strong bonds within the diaspora.

Celebrating pravasi excellence: Numerous programs are in place to captivate and inspire NRRs by highlighting the outstanding achievements of exemplary individuals from pravasi community. 'Hum Rajasthani' is a standout initiative, introducing and celebrating Pravasis who have garnered national and international recognition for their significant contributions, rich experiences and profound knowledge.

Facilitating govt.-diaspora interaction: RF has taken the lead in spearheading an innovative program, 'Miliye Sarkar Se', designed to facilitate direct interactions between the diapsora and govt. officials. This initiative enables NRRs to engage in meaningful conversations with Hon'ble Ministers and public representatives, gaining insights into sector-specific schemes and investment opportunities.

Sector-specific engagements: Within its comprehensive engagement strategy, RF has played an important role in connecting the global Rajasthani diaspora with government officials from the Govt. of Rajasthan. These interactions span a multitude of sectors, encompassing healthcare, tourism, art and culture, solar energy, skill development and education, among others. They take place both in physical and virtual settings, effectively transcending geographically boundaries for the exchange of ideas and opportunities.

A prime example of RF's commitment to education reflects in the year 2021 when the Rajasthan govt. introduced the Rajiv Gandhi Scholarship Yojna. RF and DoRI: Transforming Healthcare in Rajasthan

DoRI Foundation was set up during COVID-19 Pandemic by then CM Rajasthan Govt. under aegis of RF to promote medical service to the people with the help from NRR doctors working in other countries including USA & UK. This exceptional initiative seeks to revolutionize healthcare in Rajasthan, promoting sustainable, equitable, effective and efficient services to the states, most vulnerable individuals and communities. RF played an instrumental role in nurturing and facilitating the birth of DoRI. The foundation provided support, resources and a collaborative platform for Pravasi Rajasthani doctors to unite and channel their expertise towards a shared purpose especially at the time of pandemic. DoRI and Jaipur's SMS Medical College jointly worked on medical benefits which include beast healthcare and treatment to patients in various superspecialties' in the state. Through RF's guidance, DoRI has rapidly evolved into a dynamic force for healthcare transformation in the state. Under the aegis of RF, DoRI is actively engaged in impactful healthcare initiatives, striving to bridge the healthcare gap and uplift underserved communities. RF's efforts have yielded tangible results. NRRs, who had previously felt distant from their homeland, now have a direct channel to contribute to Rajasthan's progress. The organization has successfully facilitated several collaborations, leading to investments in various sectors, including technology, healthcare and education.

Conclusion

RF stands as a remarkable case study in how visionary leadership and innovative thinking can create pathways for a stronger connection between a state and its diaspora. It demonstrates the importance of recognizing and nurturing the ties that bind people to their roots.
