Barrymore refused to come clean in the matter, and Henry fired him. Barrymore signals alert selden to the food they have left for him , after , Henry and Watson alarmed that a murder was in their midst , armed themselves and took off across the moor to capture the criminal , when they went in the search of a suspicious things , they spotted a tall ,lone figure upon the tor , Watson was insane and belived that was an ghost of Hugo Baskervills .and he wrote the letter to the Holmes and ask her to join with him immediately .
